Protective Clothing, Coverall, Jumpsuit

## PROTECTION SCOPE

360 Degrees From Head to Ankle

Partial Protection Against Frontal Contamination

Fabric, Seam, Whole Garment

## Select Coverall or Gown?

Unless you are confident that the risk contact comes from the front, a gown may be good enough (Gown often has openings in the back). But when unknown aerosol transmissible diseases are encountered, we recommend that **an EN 14126 certified coverall is more appropriate.**
